MHSA, MOHJO, & MISHO rated

COGGINS TESTS must be presented to the secretary before numbers are issued. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to show proof of test in order to be eligible to compete.

HARD HATS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED. ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR PROTECTIVE HARNESS. Proper attire includes britches and hard soled shoes. Polo shirts may be worn.

CONTINUOUS WARM-UP: These warm-up classes will be open throughout the entire show. A horse may be entered once in each section. An entry fee must be paid. Six ribbons will be awarded at the end of the day.

CHAMPIONSHIPS AND RIBBONS: Six ribbons will be awarded in each class and prizes to third. Championship and reserve ribbon will be awarded to the top two horses in each division.

STALLS: LIMITED AMOUNT OF STABLING AVAILABLE. CALL (314-546-3124) FOR RESERVATIONS. One night \$45 When blocks of stalls are reserved trainers need to identify who they are to be billed to upon arrival. If tack stalls are to be split a list needs to be presented to the office detailing to whom and how much. If such a list is not presented the person ordering the tack stall will be held responsible for the entire amount. All horses without stalls must pay a \$25 per day grounds fee. Any one in unassigned stalls may be asked to move and pay a \$25 clean up charge. CHECK WITH THE MANAGEMENT FOR ASSIGNED STALLS. Initial bedding is included.

SCHOOLING: Schooling will be allowed Friday 12 noon and Saturday until 7:30am. Schooling is also allowed Saturday after the show. Please refer to the MHSA and the MOHJO for rules and class descriptions. www.missourihorseshowsassociation.com

PARKING: Ample parking in designated areas. Farm located at **8498 Byrnesville Rd, House Springs, MO 63051**, turn left at next intersection, Dutch Creek Road, and follow the signs to designated parking. If unloading in the barn area, please unload and park vehicles as quickly as possible to avoid congestion in barn areas. DO NOT PARK IN THE FIRE LANE, YOU WILL BE TOWED AT YOUR EXPENSE.

ADDING AT THE GATE: Due to the extreme number of entries made at the gate and the difficulty collecting said fees this service will no longer be offered at this show. Any post entries made after the class sheets are distributed will require a scratch/add sheet from the secretary...NO EXCEPTIONS!! Also no credit for scratches will be made unless the same scratch/add sheet is filled out prior to the completion of the class. ADDS AND SCRATCHES ARE NOT RECOGNIZED UNTIL PAPERWORK IS FILLED OUT IN THE OFFICE AND GIVEN TO THE SECRETARY FOR PROCESSING. No adjustment to the bill will be made due to scratches not settled in the office after the show is over.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: ANY HORSE ON PROPERTY NOT SHOWING, NEEDS TO REGISTER WITH THE SECRETARY, SIGN THE RELEASE FORM, PAY A SCHOOLING FEE (\$30), THE OFFICE FEE (\$20) AND GROUNDS FEE (\$25) BEFORE SCHOOLING. A CURRENT COGGINS TEST ALSO NEEDS TO BE PRESENTED BY ALL HORSES ON THE PROPERTY. THIS INCLUDES FRIDAY.

Hunter Divisions

- ♣ Baby Green – 2'-2'6" A horse or pony in its first year of showing.
- ♣ Beginner Rider – Open to riders who have not won over 3 blue ribbons and have not jumped over 3 ft.
- ♣ Child/Adult Hunter – 2'6" – 2'9" open to children or adults riders.
- ♣ Cross Rails – Open to all horses and riders
- ♣ Limit Hunter – 2'6" open to all horses and riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons over fences and have not jumped 3 ft or higher.
- ♣ Masters – 2' Open to riders over 50. Cannot cross enter above 2'.
- ♣ Poles – Open to all horses and riders
- ♣ Pre Green Hunter – 2'9" – 3' open to a horse of any age in its first or second year of showing and not to have shown 3'6" or higher.
- ♣ Open Hunter – 2'3" and higher. Open to all horses and riders.
- ♣ Schooling Hunter – 2' open to all horses and riders.
- ♣ Short Stirrup – 2' a junior exhibitor who has not reached their 11th birthday by Dec 1st of the current show year. Riders may not have shown over 2' with exception of the 11 and under Equitation classes.
- ♣ Walk Trot – Open to all horses and riders

Management reserves the right to split classes if entries permit.

Specialty Classes

- Derby – 2', 2'3", 2'6", 3', and 3'6" divisions. Round 1 Hunter Classic course. Round 2 Handy Hunter course. Natural obstacles (hills, banks, etc). Prize money to placed winners based on entries.
- Leadline – Open to riders learning to ride. Must be led by an experienced handler. Cannot cross enter into any other classes.
- Mini-Prix – 1M open to all horses, ponies, and riders. Prize money to placed winners base on entries.
- MHSA Medallion – 2'9" Open to junior or adult members of the MHSA. Class to be judged according the USEF rule book equitation specifications.
- MOHJO Medal – 3' Open to junior or adult members of the MOHJO. Class to be judged according the USEF rule book equitation specifications.
- Mini Medal – 2'
- Parent Leadline – a turnaround on the typical lead line class. Parents to be led by an experienced child. This class's purpose is to instill some fun into a busy show day and to remind the children to thank their parents for all they do.
- Team Scramble Jumpers – 0.7 – 0.8M – Two riders on course at the same time working as a team choosing the best course for efficiency. Refer to show office for more details.
